

Operators Maintenance Management Training Course for Unit Executive Officers and Operations Managers

Course Description

This three-day course is designed to enable police and other emergency service air operators to get the most out of their maintenance provider. It covers the regulatory, technical and human aspects of aircraft maintenance and complements the Home Office's own Police Air Support Unit Executive Officer's (UEO's) course.

Whilst it is aimed as a broad introduction to relative newcomers in the industry, the course also provides useful refreshment value to more experienced unit managers.

Teaching Method

The course is designed as facilitation type training, where delegates can join in with comments and questions during the proceedings. As well as classroom theory, the course uses helicopter components as training aids and includes hangar visits to inspect aircraft. Technical manuals and books are also used as reference material.
